The *Ambition & Destiny* Series of books was inspired by Family History research.

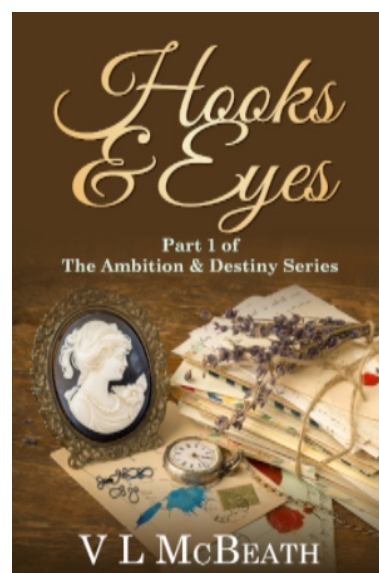
It is a family saga of love, loss and betrayal set against the backdrop of Victorian England.

### ***Hooks & Eyes***

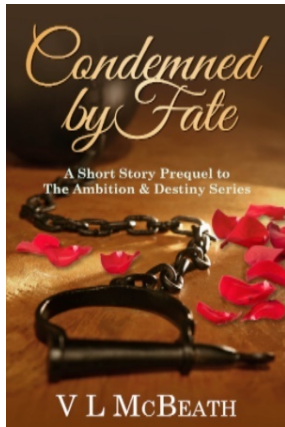
