

- List one thing you liked (eg. *I really felt for character X*, or *The book had me on the edge of my seat*.)


- Would you recommend this book (eg. I would recommend this book to others who ...)

Fact or Fiction:

The *Ambition & Destiny* Series was inspired by a true story, and over the last few months, readers have asked whether certain storylines are based on real life events. To address the questions, I'm going to start a Fact or Fiction slot.

General Principles:

Before I get into the specifics of the books, I thought I'd cover some of the overarching principles:

- 1. All major characters in the books are based on real people.
- 2. All births, deaths, and marriages are true, in terms of dates, places, and for deaths, the cause of death.
- 3. Although the names of streets have sometimes been changed (to help keep the anonymity of the real people), the locations of the story are in the right geographical area and use real street names.
- 4. I have included mention of major historical events (such as the death of Prince Albert, or the Great Exhibition), and tried to represent them in ways that would relate to the family at the time of the story.


Have you wondered whether certain parts of the books are true? If so, reply to this email and let me know. I'll address them in future newsletters.
