

I'm very excited to announce that *When Time Runs Out* is now available for preorder ©


It will be published on 15th November and to celebrate the release the preorder price has been set at 99c / 99p.

Was there a relationship between Mary and Richard?

This storyline is purely fictional.

The reason I included it was because, following Charles' death, the idea of Mary having someone to turn to appealed to me. It was also because at the time they probably saw a lot of each other. I was also intrigued because in the 19th century it was forbidden by the church for a man to marry the wife of his dead brother. This was based on the belief that when a man and wife came together in matrimony, they were seen as one person in the eyes of the church, and in law. This effectively disqualified Mary from marrying any close relatives of her husbands, potentially adding to her woes.

So what about Mr Wetherby and Sarah-Ann?

Yes, there is some truth in this, although everything about it in *Hooks & Eyes* is fiction. As the story goes on, however, it becomes more grounded in fact although the reason for its inclusion only becomes apparent in *When Time Runs Out*.
